Benefits

Child and Adolescent Case Management Services can help families find and use needed resources and funding for housing, leisure, educational and respite needs. These services are designed to help families receive the maximum support in their community and access all available resources.

Eligibility

Children ages birth to 18, who have developmental, emotional or behavioral issues and who live in James City County, City of Poquoson, City of Williamsburg or York County are eligible for services.

Staff

Case Managers help link families to the resources and community services they need in order to care for their child. They help identify needs, develop service plans, coordinate services with other providers and monitor services once they are in place. Case Managers find new ways to help families through a wide variety of activities and services.

All services are provided by our clinically trained professional staff. Colonial Behavioral Health programs are licensed by the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services.

Parent Resources

Child and Adolescent Case Management Services can help ease the demands placed on parents of children with special needs. Through Case Management Services, parents can find advocacy services, support groups, respite care and parent education and training services, which help improve the quality of life for themselves and their children.

Community Partners

Colonial Behavioral Health works closely with other local agencies such as:

Fees

Services are provided on a fee for service basis. Most insurance plans and HMOs are accepted, including Medicaid. Persons without insurance coverage are charged according to ability to pay, based on income and dependents. No one will be denied services because they are unable to pay.
